Arzneimitteltherapie im Alter – Pharmakokinetik, Arzneimittelwechselwirkungen, Leitlinien bei Multimorbidität

Gute medizinische Versorgung mit hoher Evidenzbasierung ist für die Gruppe der (hoch-)betagten Patienten keine Selbstverständlichkeit. Ursachen dafür sind u. a. die Komplexität und Interaktion multipler Erkrankungen in dieser Patientengruppe und eine nicht immer umfassende Datenlage aus kontrollierten klinischen Studien bei einer erheblichen Streuung des allgemeinen Gesundheitszustandes, der körperlichen und der geistigen Funktionen. Darüber hinaus beeinflussen altersbedingte physiologische Veränderungen die Pharmakokinetik und Pharmakodynamik vieler Medikamente. Die klinische Relevanz dieser Veränderungen ist allerdings gering, im Vergleich zu den durch Multimorbidität bedingten Einflüssen sowie dem sich aus der Polypharmazie ergebenden Risiko für Arzneimittelwechselwirkungen. Daraus ergibt sich oftmals die Frage: Wann ist weniger mehr?

1 GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR REGISTRATION

Registration

After completion of the registration with CSi Hamburg GmbH, as a mandated service agency, a binding contract between the participant and AGAH e. V. becomes effective. Participation AGAH Member: free of charge. The Regular registration fee (40 EUR) is per person, according to §4, para. 22, German Turnover-Tax Law exempt from VAT and charged and collected on behalf of AGAH e. V., Goer- nestraße 30, 20249 Hamburg/Germany (taxpayer ID number: DE25876120). The participant will receive a written confirmation/invoice with paying details first and have to pay the registration fee within the payment period.

CANCELLATION

AGAH-Member: If you are unable to attend the web seminar, we kindly ask you to cancel in writing to agah-meetings@csihamburg.de

Regular registration: Cancellations made up to 2 weeks before the start of the event (18 March 2025) are free of charge; A cancellation received after 18 March 2025 is not refundable. All refunds will be settled after the event. Substitutes will be accepted at any time. All changes or cancellations must be submitted to CSi Hamburg GmbH in writing.

Data use and storage

The personal data you provide will only be used by CSi Hamburg GmbH to fulfil the contract and will be handled in accordance with the provisions of the Ger- man Data Protection Regulation (DSGVO). For the duration of the contractual relationship, the service provider may store and use the personal data of the participants in compliance with the applicable data protection regulations. The collection, storage and processing of your personal data is necessary for your regi- stration for the web seminar. Your data will be used exclusively for the purpose of organising and conducting the event. Your data will only be passed on to third parties if they are directly involved in the running of the event and if the organisa- tional progress makes this necessary (organiser). The legislative body requires us to obtain your active consent. Within the registration process, participants give their consent for their surname, first name and institution/company to be stored in the list of participants. You will receive information about the data we have stored about you without having to give a reason and you can have this data blocked, corrected or deleted at any time. You can also revoke your consent to the use of your data at any time without giving reasons. The web seminar will take place via an online meeting platform: Microsoft Teams. Please note that this platform may belong to a company based in the United States of America. Your data will be passed on to the service provider for use. Due to a possible location in the United States of America, the same data protection regulations as in Germany do not apply.

Liability

CSi Hamburg GmbH acts as an intermediary party and is liable within the scope of due diligence as a prudent businessman in accordance with the statutory provisions. Liability - for whatever legal reason - is limited to intent and gross negligence. The liability of commissioned third parties shall remain unaffected.
