Patients in Phase I - The earlier the better? – Making the right population choice in first-in-human and early development trials

Including patients already in first-in-human trials is often seen as the fastest route to clinically relevant insights—but is it always the best choice? What do current guidelines and regulatory expectations actually say about including (or excluding) patients in early development, and how much of the perceived “trend” toward earlier patient inclusion is real versus anecdotal?

In this AGAH member webinar, we'll explore the key trade-offs between rapid pharmacologic learning in healthy volunteers and earlier, potentially more relevant clinical signals in patients — while also addressing practical implications such as eligibility criteria, safety margins, interpretability of endpoints, operational complexity, and decision-making speed.

We'll conclude with a pragmatic toolbox: core aspects and questions to consider to select the most suitable population and design for the trial at hand.

Registration

CANCELLATION

Regular registration: Cancellations made up to 2 weeks prior to the start of the event are free of charge; any cancellations received after this time will not be refunded. All refunds will be settled after the event. A substitute participant can be accepted at any time. All changes or cancellations must be submitted in writing to CSi Hamburg GmbH.

Data use and storage
